Something that's also hard to believe is that this Sunday will mark what would have been our son, Sean's Third Birthday. On a positive note, within the next few weeks, we will be bringing this year's collection of tabs and other "gifts" to PRMH, for our annual donation in Sean's memory. We really won't know how many (hundreds of) pounds of tabs it is until we go to PRMH. We're very happy and appreciative that Thanks to so many people, we've been able to collect a few hundred pounds of tabs this year! We'll also be giving them 56 videotapes and a number of brand-new children's toys, that kind folks have donated.

As far as our SJDMF Campership Fund, we're able to send 2 seriously-ill children to Ronald McDonald Camp this year, bringing our total to 8 kids in 4 years! This is an awesome accomplishment, something that wouldn't have happened if it weren't for people donating from everywhere and a 'little creativity.' I know I had wanted to send 3 kids this year like we did last, but we fell a few hundred dollars short on our target date. As it is, we still feel extremely good averaging sending 2 kids per year. The good news also is that we have enough to send at least one PRMH kid each year almost through 2009!

I apologize that I haven't been able to keep up with collecting and Thanking everyone for their tab donations as much as I should. When I put my hand in my pocket to get change, I usually have at least a few tabs there too! Fortunately I usually take the tabs out before the clothes end up in the washer! ;-)

We are also extremely happy that Sean's spirit continues to grow as people are also sending tabs to their RMH's in Florida, Michigan, Virginia, Indiana, Texas & California. We recently received word from one of our good friends in California, who said that they've collected over 20 lbs. of tabs in just a short time for us (they drink lots of soda). They were originally going to mail them to us, but we suggested instead that they contact their local RMH and donate them to their tab program in Sean's name.
